Eligibility to compete: A current USJI, USJF, USJA membership card **MUST** be presented at registration along with the LIABILITY WAIVER and ENTRY FEE. There will be no refunds of the entry fee.

Contest Rules: Current IJF contest rules will govern EXCEPT no chokes or arm locks for 12 years old and younger. No arm locks for ages 13 to 16 years old. Any judoka under the age of 16 who wishes to compete in the Senior division will compete with no exceptions to the IJF rules. Anyone competing up in rank divisions will be subject to the rules for that group. Any attempt to perform any technique with the intent to injure the opponent as determined by the officials on the mat will be an automatic hansoku make.

Elimination System: Modified Double elimination System will be used. The winner of the winners pool shall get first place, the winner of the loser pool shall get second place and the loser of the final match in the loser pool shall get third place.

Novice division will be considered all Junior ranks and Senior ranks below Sankyu. Sankyu and above will be considered Advanced. Mixed teams will be ranked off of the highest level player. In the Open Kata division, any kata can be performed. There are not separate divisions for each kata.

Masters Divisions:

Judoka 30 years and older may compete in the Masters division. Divisions will not be chosen until after registration is closed

NOTE: The tournament director reserves the right to alter or change any division to establish a more equitable competitive division. Any changes will be discussed with the coaches and/or the competitors involved prior to the actual change. There will be no single winner of a division.

Awards : Medals for first, second and third places. Trophy for Junior Team and Senior Team (by points based on 5 pts for 1st, 3 pts for 2nd and 1 pt for 3rd. Trophy for Outstanding Junior Judoka and Outstanding Senior Judoka
